Thanksgiving Worship with Holy Communion on Wednesday, November 23



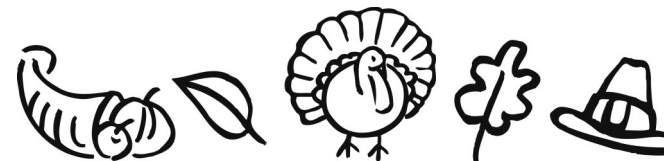
The church office will be closed on Thursday, November 24 and Friday, November 25 in observation of the Thanksgiving holiday.
